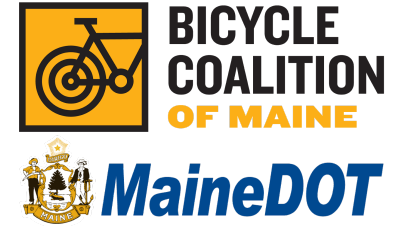


How to Draw a Bicycle

In 8 Easy Steps



FIRST: Go grab a pen and some paper and try this: Using only your memory, draw a bicycle.

Drawing a bicycle from memory is harder than it sounds! Only about 25% manage to accurately sketch a bike. Check out what the other 75% sometimes look like: gianlucagimini.it/prototypes/velocipedia.html

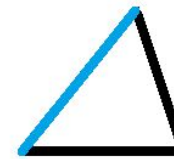
1 - Seat tube



2 - Chain stay



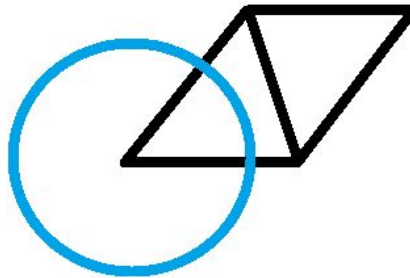
3 - Seat Stay



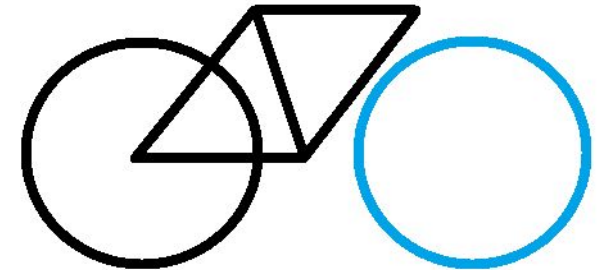
4 - Top tube and down tube



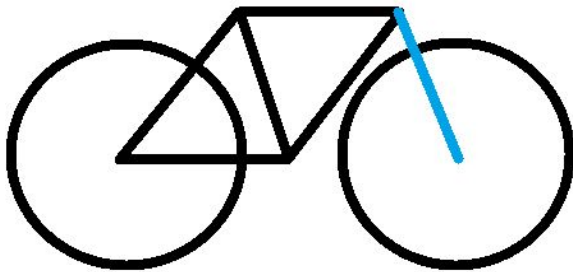
5 - Rear wheel



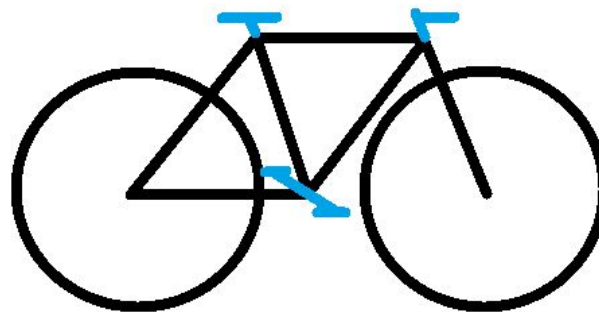
6 - Front wheel
